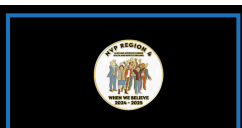

I thought I would share my favorite line of the Jaycee Creed with you as we embark on this “When We Believe” journey with NVP Carla. “We Believe that faith in God gives meaning and purpose to human life.” This probably comes as no surprise to many of you as being my favorite line of the creed. I was thinking about how many times I have probably said the creed when I began writing this article. I would guess it has to be at least hundreds. # North Carolina JCI Senate



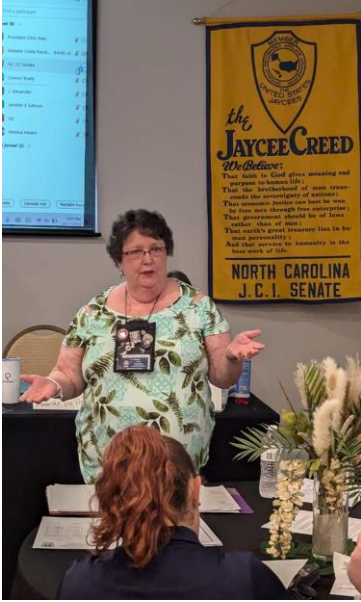
## The Going Ons in North Carolina

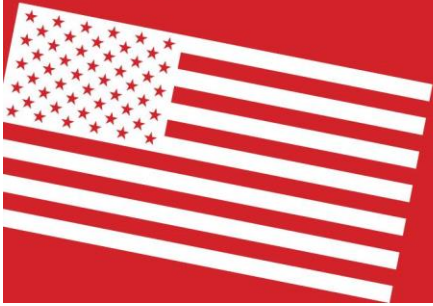

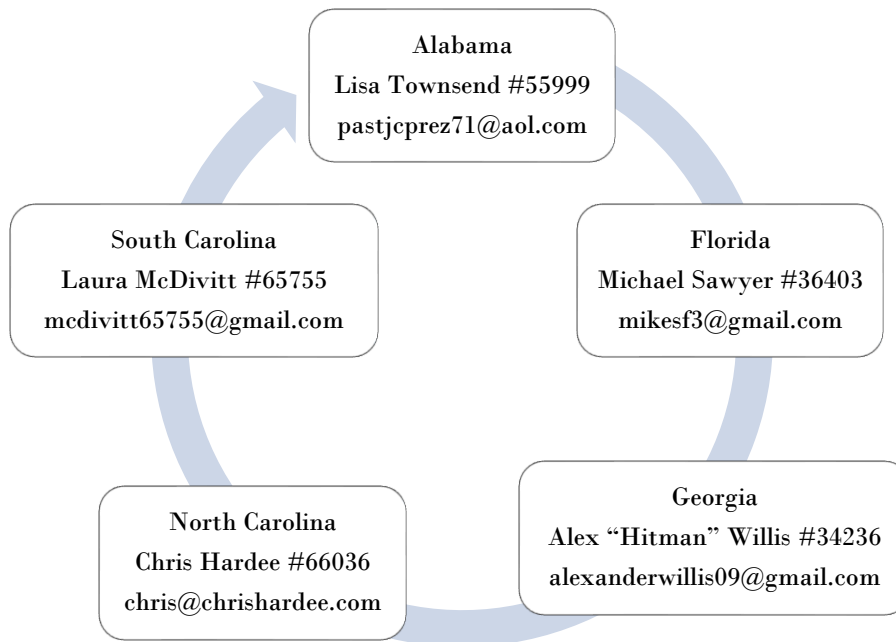
